Wine description and information

Lagrein is one of South Tyrol’s most important native grape varieties and has always been closely associated with Bolzano, particularly the historic wine-growing district of Gries. At our winery, we interpret Lagrein in several different styles – from the fresh Lagrein Rosé to the powerful Lagrein Riserva. For our **Lagrein VILLA SCHMID**, the grapes are carefully harvested by hand and fermented in stainless steel. The wine is then aged in wood, with **25% matured in American oak barriques**. In the glass, it shows an intense garnet-red colour with violet reflections. On the nose, it reveals a complex bouquet of violets, dark berries and delicate spices, complemented by subtle notes of cinnamon and vanilla. On the palate, it is fruit-driven and structured, with flavours of wild berries and blueberries and a finely integrated touch of oak.
